Dear Chairman Thune and Ranking Member Nelson:

We write to urge inclusion of significant certification and regulatory reforms for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAÁ) as part of a long term FAA reauthorization bill this year. These reforms will help bring new safety technology to the market, strengthen U.S. aviation sales and exports, and more effectively utilize the resources of the FAA and industry.

The Senate Aviation Subcommittee held a hearing earlier this year on certification reform, and it is broadly acknowledged that such reforms will help small and large businesses, and drive U.S. competitiveness and job growth. As one witness testified, a delay in certification can be devastating, particularly for a small business.

These reforms that you included in last year's FAA reauthorization enjoyed strong bipartisan support, and the bill saw a 95-3 vote. Specifically, the bill contained provisions to:

- Secure fuller utilization of the FAA's Organizational Designation Authorization (ODA) program to improve safety while reducing delays and the cost of aircraft certification and better leverage resources to help aviation suppliers;
- Require FAA to more actively engage with aviation authorities globally to facilitate the validation of U.S. certified products and safety standards;
- Reduce FAA's inconsistent interpretation of their own regulations; and
- Improve the flow of new aircraft designs and safety technologies into the airplane and rotorcraft fleet.

We recognize your leadership in developing these reforms and want to work with you to move them forward and enact them in a timely manner this year as part of FAA reauthorization.
