

42 companies across Washington are working to supply Artemis.

Nine Washington companies are manufacturing supplies for Exploration Ground Systems (EGS), based at NASA's Kennedy Space Center in Florida. EGS was established to develop systems and facilities necessary for rockets and spacecraft during assembly, transport, and launch. EGS's mission is to transform the center from a historically government-only launch complex to a spaceport that can handle several different kinds of spacecraft and rockets—both government and commercial.

14 companies in Washington provide critical materials for NASA's Orion spacecraft, which is built to take humans farther in space than ever before. Orion will serve as the exploration vehicle that will carry the crew to space, provide emergency abort capability, sustain the crew during the space travel, and provide safe reentry from deep space return velocities. Orion will launch on NASA's new heavy-lift rocket, the Space Launch System.


16 Washington companies supply NASA's Space Launch System (SLS) rocket, the most powerful rocket built to date. SLS will enable astronauts to begin their journey to explore destinations far into the solar system.

One Washington company is supporting development work for NASA's Human Landing System Program (HLS). The HLS is the final mode of transportation that will take astronauts to the lunar surface throughout Artemis. On early missions, the astronauts will live inside the pressurized crew cabin portion of the lander for up to a week.

Two companies in Washington are working on Gateway, a multi-purpose outpost orbiting the Moon that will provide essential support for long-term, human missions to the lunar surface and serves as a staging point for deep space exploration.






